If you have kept up with the news recently you will be aware of the burning land question being discussed around our country. This is an issue we have been aware of over 30 years as we have worked with our beloved Coloured people, visiting in tiny RDP houses, Wendy-houses and shacks most of which had far more people living in them than they were ever intended to hold. This was recently brought home to us again on a visit to an old couple and their daughter and grandchildren. This family of six live in a 6x3mtr one room shack, in a back yard along beside 3 other shacks. At least 20 people along with the house family all use one bathroom and toilet. As you can imagine the conditions are horrendous and these people are desperate for a place of their own. Sadly they all want land and houses but want nothing to do with the Lord, the One “that is able to do exceeding abundantly above all that we ask or think” and give them an eternal home in heaven. Thank you for helping us get the message of Jesus and His wonderful salvation out to these desperate people. Your love, prayer and financial support enable us to go to these poor people in their terrible conditions with confidence in the great news of Christ’s love.

Macassar

The outreach program on Tuesdays is running out of space as we now feed up to 250 children and adults with a nourishing meal, fruit and drink. Interestingly the numbers have increased through the adults now coming – 130 this past Tuesday. More importantly than the food we give them is the gospel preached to them before they get their meal. The local Councillor for Macassar has taken an interest in what we are doing through the outreach and our Friday night Addiction Program and is looking at supplying us with property. Cloeteville

With the cold weather settling over the Boland, Stellenbosch’s homeless and vagrants are in a helpless situation. Over the last month our people (who don’t have much themselves) graciously donated what they could to help those less fortunate than themselves and this past Saturday we took hot soup, coffee, eats, blankets, clothing, washing supplies and gospel tracts and covered the area helping these poor people with these basic needs. All those we came across had a good breakfast, received clothing and blankets and most importantly the gospel, shared by word of mouth and through the tracts.
